Performance Evidence

An individual demonstrating competency must satisfy all of the elements and performance criteria in this unit.

There must be evidence that the individual has managed the work health and safety processes for at least one work group, including:

- identified the required workplace health and safety legal requirements for the pulp or paper manufacturing area
- reviewed and monitored workplace health and safety hazard identification and risk management processes to ensure consistency with legal requirements
- monitored work group members to ensure that they complied with workplace health and safety requirements
- managed a participative process for work group members, and identified how issues raised by members will be addressed
- implemented at least one workplace health and safety induction or training program for work group members.

Knowledge Evidence

An individual must be able to demonstrate the knowledge required to perform the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit. This includes knowledge of:

- sources of information on workplace health and safety legislation, standards, compliance codes and guidance material relevant to the pulp and paper manufacturing industry
- legal and regulatory requirements and organisational procedures for workplace health and safety processes, including:
 - managing workplace health and safety information, records and reporting
 - managing consultation and participative opportunities and incident investigation
 - undertaking workplace health and safety training needs assessment
 - managing workplace health and safety employee induction and training
 - managing workplace health and safety risk

- developing a workplace health and safety action plan
- common pulp and paper industry workplace hazards, including chemicals, bodily fluids, noise, manual handling, work postures, underfoot hazards, slips and trips, moving parts of machinery, mobile plant, fatigue, stress, bullying and occupational violence
- techniques and procedures for identifying and addressing hazard and risk in the work environment, including:
 - hazard identification procedures
 - principles of risk assessment
 - the hierarchy of control and its application.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment of the skills in this unit of competency must take place under the following conditions:

- physical conditions:
 - skills must be demonstrated in a pulp and/or paper manufacturing facility or an environment that accurately represents workplace conditions
- resources, equipment and materials:
 - work health and safety systems and processes
- specifications:
 - workplace procedures relating to work health and safety requirements and processes
 - work health and safety legislation and regulatory requirements
- relationships:
 - team members.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
