Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to complete tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit in the context of the job role:

- record a proceeding in two or more types of courts and:
 - meet required deadlines
 - make clear announcements
 - produce high quality recording of court proceedings.

Knowledge Evidence

Demonstrated knowledge required to complete the tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit:

- legislation, regulations, policies, procedures and practice relating to recordings of court proceedings
- structure, roles, functions, procedures and protocols of courts
- principles of judicial independence.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must be demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions.

Assessment must ensure access to:

- legislation, regulations, policies, procedures and practice relating to court recordings
- a live courtroom
- court recording equipment.

Assessors must satisfy the Standards for Registered Training Organisations' requirements for assessors.
