Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to complete tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit in the context of the job role, and on at least one occasion:

- apply legislation, regulations, policies, procedures and guidelines relating to risk management
- undertake research and analysis of the wider context affecting the organisation
- · monitor and review risks and risk treatments
- communicate and consult with stakeholders
- apply problem solving using conceptual and reasoning skills in the implementation and review of risk management in the workplace
- use formal language and style for written plans
- · communicate with others about complex information
- explain complex, formal documents and assist others to apply them in the workplace.

Knowledge Evidence

Demonstrated knowledge required to complete the tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit:

- legislation, regulations, policies, procedures and guidelines relating to risk management in the organisation
- risk management strategy
- organisational structure, functions and operation
- audit requirements
- risk management cycle
- the relationship of risk to context and how the context may define the risks
- the importance of consultation and communication at every stage of the risk management cycle
- approval processes
- evaluation methodologies
- the diversity of risks in the public sector
- relevant risk management standards.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must be demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions.

Assessment must ensure access to:

- · legislation, regulations, policies, procedures and guidelines relating to risk management
- resources and equipment of the working environment.

Assessors must satisfy the Standards for Registered Training Organisations' requirements for assessors.
