Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to complete tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit in the context of the job role, and on at least one occasion:

- access and interpret complex and formal documents
- administer legislative requirements
- exercise discretion consistent with legislative and procedural requirements when addressing a non-compliance issue
- communicate with others involving exchanges of complex oral and written information.

Knowledge Evidence

Demonstrated knowledge required to complete the tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit:

- types of legislation, regulations and guidelines applicable to organisation and work group
- public sector codes of ethics and conduct
- organisational procedures and protocols applicable to job role for responding to legislative issues and consequences of non-compliance
- procedures for acting on and reporting possible breaches of legislation.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must be demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions.

Assessment must ensure access to:

- types of legislation, regulations and guidelines applicable to organisation and job role
- organisational procedures and protocols applicable to job role for responding to legislative requirements.

Assessors must satisfy the Standards for Registered Training Organisations' requirements for assessors.
