Performance Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the candidate must demonstrate evidence of performance of the following on at least one occasion.

- reading and writing complex documents
- applying understanding of supplier issues and supply chain management in the context of strategic procurement
- identifying and assessing strategic procurement options and alternatives
- undertaking research and business analysis
- managing financial and other resources
- exercising best practice in strategic procurement and procurement legislation.

Knowledge Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the depth of knowledge demonstrated must be appropriate to the job context of the candidate.

- Commonwealth, state or territory, and local government legislation, policies, practices and guidelines relating to strategic procurement
- organisational procurement policies, practices and approval processes
- aspects of law of contract, trade practices law, and commercial law relating to strategic procurement
- probity principles and issues
- codes of conduct, codes of practice and standards of individual behaviour relating to procurement decisions
- government procurement environment

- legal requirements of government procurement
- implications of particular procurement arrangements
- whole of life considerations
- cultural issues relating to strategic procurement and industry development in certain industry sectors
- relationship management at all personnel levels
- environmental, sustainability and corporate social responsibility principles relevant to strategic procurement

Assessment Conditions
