Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to complete tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit in the context of the job role, and:

- conduct two actual or simulated search and seizure operations and for each of the operations:
 - apply legislation, regulation and procedures in the context of search and seizure
 - write a report using standard format
 - complete required post search and seizure tasks in accordance with organisational procedures.

Knowledge Evidence

Demonstrated knowledge required to complete the tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit:

- enabling legislation, regulations and procedures for area of jurisdiction
- standard operating procedures for search and for seizure
- organisational policies and procedures, including those dealing with physical evidence or obtaining a warrant, where relevant
- roles of expert and other personnel
- procedures for dealing with physical evidence
- rules of evidence
- use of equipment and resources.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must be demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions.

Assessment must ensure access to:

- legislation, regulations and procedures for area of jurisdiction
- · standard operating procedures for search and for seizure
- organisational policies and procedures
- resources and equipment of the working environment.

Assessors must satisfy the Standards for Registered Training Organisations' requirements for assessors.
