Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to complete tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit in the context of the job role, and:

- undertake two regulatory inspections, and for each of the inspections:
 - confirm regulatory activities and responsibilities
 - identify any non-compliance and recommended action
 - identify any offence that requires prosecution
 - write report using standard formats.

Knowledge Evidence

Demonstrated knowledge required to complete the tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit:

- legislation and regulation that applies to routine and non-routine inspections in area of jurisdiction
- enabling legislation
- organisational policies and procedures for routine and non-routine inspections including:
 - inspection procedures
 - monitoring procedures
- elements of an offence
- responses to non-compliance
- workplace and industry environments.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must be demonstrated in either a workplace environment or a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions.

Assessment must ensure access to:

- legislation and regulation that applies to routine and non-routine inspections in area of jurisdiction
- organisational policies and procedures for routine and non-routine inspections
- resources and equipment of the working environment.

Assessors must satisfy the Standards for Registered Training Organisations' requirements for assessors.
