Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to complete tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit in the context of the job role, and on at least one occasion:

- communicate with others on matters involving exchanges of complex information when interpreting and assessing contracts
- use technology to conduct research, make enquiries, review available data, access legislative requirements and record outcomes.

Knowledge Evidence

Evidence of the ability to complete tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit in the context of the job role, and on at least one occasion:

- communicate with others on matters involving exchanges of complex information when interpreting and assessing contracts
- use technology to conduct research, make enquiries, review available data, access legislative requirements and record outcomes.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must be demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions.

Assessment must ensure access to:

- legislation, regulations, rulings, commissioner practices and other applicable case law relating to contracts
- legislative decision-making process
- organisational procedures and protocols for interpretation and assessment of contracts
- information systems, equipment and resources of the working environment.

Assessors must satisfy the Standards for Registered Training Organisations' requirements for assessors.
