# Assessment Requirements for PSPTRP001 Intercept vehicles and assess vehicle compliance

1	These Assessment Requirements were released in PSP Public Sector Training Package release 1.0 and meet the Standards for Training Packages.

## Performance Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the candidate must demonstrate evidence of performance of the following on at least one occasion.

- using effective communication including interviewing, listening and conflict resolution with a diverse range of people
- reading and interpreting legislation and regulations
- completing documentation, notices, reports and records
- applying public sector legislation, including work health and safety and environmental procedures, in the context of road transport compliance
- undertaking at least three actual or simulated vehicle assessments, on three separate occasions and for different vehicle configurations, where one may be an unladen vehicle
- maintaining operational safety
- enforcing legislation within the limits of the officer's authority

## Knowledge Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the depth of knowledge demonstrated must be appropriate to the job context of the candidate.

- legislation, regulations and standards, including load restraint guides
- work health and safety in the context of assessing vehicle compliance
- sanctions and/or penalties
- enforcement powers
- offences
- cautions
- rules of evidence
- standards and specifications for all items requiring inspection
- contingency management processes for unplanned events

## Assessment Conditions

Some components of this unit require assessment in a workplace environment (real or simulated) therefore the unit is not suitable for fully external or electronic based assessment.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
