Performance Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the candidate must demonstrate evidence of performance of the following on at least one occasion.

- applying risk management principles
- undertaking research and analysis
- communicating and influencing in order to facilitate change in the workplace
- reading and explaining complex and formal documents, including legislation and their application to clients' situations
- providing advice and participating in discussions involving complex exchanges of oral information
- facilitating improvement in workplace legislative performance in 3 or more contexts or on 3 or more occasions.

Knowledge Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the depth of knowledge demonstrated must be appropriate to the job context of the candidate.

- work health and safety and/or workers compensation and/or injury management and/or workplace relations legislation, policies and requirements
- risk management principles
- change management processes

Assessment Conditions
