### **Unit Descriptor**

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This unit covers the competency required to command, lead and manage groups of up to 12 personnel during defensive operations.

Defensive operations are characterised by extreme environmental conditions with high levels of risk of serious injury or death from hostile action. Supervision during defensive operations requires supervisors to be incisive in a fluid and demanding environment, to act independently, and to lead by example.

Command is the authority a commander in the military service lawfully exercises over subordinates by virtue of rank or assignment.

### **Application of the Unit**
