Requirements for completion of the qualification

- eleven (11) elective units of which:
 - at least six (6) must be chosen from group A
 - up to five (5) must be chosen from group B
 - up to one (1) unit may be chosen from Certificate II, Certificate III or Certificate IV level from this, or any other Training Package or accredited course.

Units chosen must be relevant to the job function.

There are no prerequisites to imported units listed in this qualification. Where a unit is imported as an elective care must be taken to ensure that all prerequisites specified are complied with.
