Packaging Rules

Requirements for completion of the qualification

The following provides the packaging rules for this qualification, followed by the list of relevant units of competency.

Successful completion of sixteen (16) units of competency made up of:

- four (4) core units, and
- twelve (12) elective units of which:
 - one (1) must be chosen from group A
 - at least eight (8) must be chosen from group B
 - one (1) may be chosen from group C
 - up to two (2) may come from Certificate II, Certificate III or Certificate IV level from this, or any other Training Package or accredited course

Units chosen must be relevant to the job function.

There are prerequisites to imported units listed in this qualification. Where a unit is imported as an elective care must be taken to ensure that all prerequisites specified are complied with. *RIIGOV201D* Comply with site work processes/procedures is a mandatory requirement for those working in Coal Mining
