### **Qualification Description**

This qualification reflects the role of employees such as senior drillers working in an oil/gas context. They perform tasks involving a broad range of varied activities most of which are complex and non-routine. They are responsible for the quantity and quality of the output of others and contribute to the development of technical solutions to non-routine problems. No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.
