Qualification Description

This qualification reflects the role of mine managers in an underground metalliferous mine who perform tasks involving a high level of autonomy and requiring the application of significant judgement in planning and determining the selection of equipment/roles/techniques for themselves and others. They are required to demonstrate the application of a broad range of technical, managerial, coordination and planning skills and implement mine management plans.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification.

Packaging Rules

The following table provides the packaging rules for this qualification, followed by the list of relevant units of competency.

7 core units plus

6 elective units, of which:

- at least three (3) must be chosen from Group A
- no more than three (3) may be chosen from Group B
