Plan and prepare to safely handle bituminous materials	<p>1.1 Access, interpret and apply bituminous materials handling documentation and ensure the work activity is compliant</p> <p>1.2 Obtain, read, interpret, clarify and confirm work requirements</p> <p>1.3 Identify and address potential risks, hazards and environmental issues, and implement control measures</p> <p>1.4 Select and wear personal protective equipment appropriate for work activities</p> <p>1.5 Confirm and apply environmental protection and safety requirements</p> <p>1.6 Select and check for faults tools and equipment to carry out tasks</p> <p>1.7 Obtain and interpret emergency procedures, and be prepared for fire/accident/emergency</p>

Work safely with bituminous materials	<p>2.1 Identify characteristics and uses of bituminous materials and additives used in surfacing</p> <p>2.2 Handle bituminous materials and complete work plan</p> <p>2.3 Continually monitor hazards and risks, and ensure safety of self, other personnel, plant and equipment</p>
3. Demonstrate First Aid for bitumen burns	<p>3.1 Perform First Aid in the case of a bitumen burn</p> <p>3.2 Attach 'Bitumen Burn Tag' to victims of burns who are to be treated off site</p>
4. Clean up	<p>4.1 Clear work area and dispose of or recycle materials in accordance with project environmental management plan</p> <p>4.2 Clean, check, maintain and store tools and equipment</p> <p>4.3 Carry out housekeeping requirements</p>
