RIICBS203E Safely handle bituminous materials

Modification History

This unit replaces RIICBS203D Safely handle bituminous materials. Minor endorseable amendments have been made to Elements, Performance Criteria, Foundation Skills, Performance Evidence and Knowledge Evidence to better reflect current industry practices and clarify training outcomes.

Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to safely handle bituminous materials in civil construction.

It applies to those working in operational roles. They generally perform routine tasks and work under direct supervision.

Licensing, legislative, regulatory and certification requirements that apply to this unit can vary between states, territories, and industry sectors. Relevant information must be sourced prior to application of the unit.

3. Demonstrate First Aid for bitumen burns	3.1 Perform First Aid in to demonstrate First Aid process in the case of a bitumen burn 3.2 Display 'Bitumen Burn Tag' in a simulation exercise to show that victims of burns who are to be treated off site
4. Clean up	4.1 Clear work area and dispose of and recycle materials according to workplace procedures and environmental requirements 4.2 Clean, check, perform maintenance on in scope of own role, and store tools and equipment 4.3 Carry out housekeeping to workplace requirements
