Plan and prepare to conduct aggregate spreader box operations	<p>1.1 Access, interpret and apply aggregate spreader box operations documentation and ensure the work activity is compliant</p> <p>1.2 Obtain, read, interpret, clarify and confirm work requirements</p> <p>1.3 Identify and address potential risks, hazards and environmental issues, and implement control measures</p> <p>1.4 Select and wear personal protective equipment appropriate for work activities</p> <p>1.5 Confirm and apply environmental protection and safety requirements</p> <p>1.6 Obtain, interpret and implement traffic management signage</p>
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	<p>requirements</p> <p>1.7 Select and check for faults plant, tools and equipment to carry out tasks</p> <p>1.8 Obtain and interpret emergency procedures, and be prepared for fire/accident/emergency</p>
2. Set up to conduct aggregate spreader box operations	<p>2.1 Place cut on/cut off paper in preparation for bitumen spraying and at the end of the spray run</p> <p>2.2 Connect equipment to the truck prior to operation</p> <p>2.3 Set spreader box to required width</p> <p>2.4 Check spreader box to ensure correct operation</p> <p>2.5 Check spreader box calibration</p> <p>2.6 Establish communication with the truck driver</p> <p>2.7 Check and record size of aggregate prior to spreading</p>
3. Spread aggregate	<p>3.1 Remove cut on/cut off paper in preparation for aggregate spreading</p> <p>3.2 Coordinate opening and closing of the spreader box accurately with speed and application of aggregate</p> <p>3.3 Instruct driver to adjust speed, line or angle of body as required</p> <p>3.4 Monitor spread rate and make adjustments</p> <p>3.5 Complete spreading</p>
4. Perform hand spreading and spotting duties	<p>4.1 Check and correct uniformity of run as required</p> <p>4.2 Use correct hand spreading method</p>
5. Disconnect and clean up	<p>5.1 Disconnect spreader box after operation</p> <p>5.2 Check to ensure truck is completely free of spreader and the spreader has all connecting parts correctly positioned for transportation or further use</p> <p>5.3 Clear work area and dispose of or recycle materials</p> <p>5.4 Clean, check, maintain and store plant, tools and equipment</p> <p>5.5 Carry out housekeeping requirements</p>
