RIICBS402E Supervise the application of bituminous sprayed treatments

Modification History

This unit replaces RIICBS402D Apply the principles for the application of bituminous sprayed treatment. Minor endorseable amendments have been made to Elements, Performance Criteria, Foundation Skills, Performance Evidence and Knowledge Evidence to better reflect current industry practices and clarify training outcomes.

Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to apply the principles for supervising the application of bituminous sprayed treatments in civil construction.

It applies to those working in supervisory roles. They are generally responsible for the output of others, contribute to the development of technical solutions to non-routine problems and apply management plans to the workplace.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.
