Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to conduct paver operations in civil construction, including operating and relocating pavers and carrying out plant maintenance.

It applies to those working in operational roles. They generally work under minimal supervision to undertake a broad range of tasks in varied work contexts, using some discretion and judgement in selecting equipment, services or contingency measures.

Licensing, legislative and certification requirements that apply to this unit can vary between states, territories and industry sectors. Users must check requirements with relevant body before applying the unit.

5. Carry out plant maintenance	5.1 Conduct inspection and fault finding according to manufacturer specifications and site requirements
	5.2 Carry out routine operational servicing and lubrication tasks according to manufacturer specifications and site requirements
	5.3 Carry out minor maintenance according to manufacturer specifications and site requirements
	5.4 Record machine performance according to site requirements
6. Conduct clean-up activities	6.1 Clear work area and recycle or dispose of materials according to site requirements
	6.2 Clean, check, maintain and store plant, tools and equipment according to manufacturer specifications and site requirements

Foundation Skills

SKILL	DESCRIPTION
Numeracy	Calculates basic measurements including mass and dimensions
Self-management	Monitors and minimises own exposure to worksite risks and hazards during activities
Writing	Completes maintenance records using sector specific vocabulary, grammatical structures and work conventions
