Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to supervise rigid pavement construction in civil construction, including preparing team members to construct rigid pavements and overseeing and reporting on task execution.

It applies to those working in supervisory roles. They generally perform a broad range of operational activities in their area of responsibility and are responsible for monitoring a safe work environment.

Licensing, legislative and certification requirements that apply to this unit can vary between states, territories, and industry sectors. Users must check requirements with relevant body before applying the unit.

5. Report on execution of tasks	5.1 Complete and submit reports according to site requirements5.2 Recommend required changes to confirm task execution meets job requirements
