Plan and prepare to construct portals	<p>1.1 Access, interpret and apply construct portals documentation and ensure the work activity is compliant</p> <p>1.2 Obtain, interpret, clarify and confirm work instructions before proceeding</p> <p>1.3 Identify, obtain and implement the traffic signage requirements</p> <p>1.4 Select and check for faults plant, tools and equipment to carry out tasks</p> <p>1.5 Select and wear personal protective equipment appropriate for work activities</p> <p>1.6 Obtain and interpret emergency procedures, and be prepared for fire/accident/emergency</p>
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	<p>1.7 Identify preliminary ground work requirements to support portal surrounds prior to excavation</p> <p>1.8 Identify, address and report environmental issues, potential hazards and risks</p>
2. Excavate portal shape	<p>2.1 Determine location, alignment and direction portals from details contained in job drawings and specifications</p> <p>2.2 Identify and apply method of construction for portal</p> <p>2.3 Prepare material for the construction process of the selected portals according to design plans and specifications</p> <p>2.4 Complete excavation to plan</p> <p>2.5 Control dust and noise suppression in accordance with EPA and WHS requirements</p>
3. Support excavation and form portal surrounds	<p>3.1 Install sheeting and/or first set to specifications</p> <p>3.2 Excavate and trim battering to design and drainage specifications</p>
4. Install ground support	<p>4.1 Identify ground support from project drawings and specifications</p> <p>4.2 Construct base to detail drawings and specifications</p> <p>4.3 Install ground support and shotcrete/concrete</p> <p>4.4 Place drainage and seepage provisions</p>
5. Conduct housekeeping activities	<p>5.1 Clear work area and dispose of or recycle materials</p> <p>5.2 Clean, check, maintain and store plant, tools and equipment</p> <p>5.3 Carry out housekeeping activities</p>
