Apply First Aid	<p>3.1 Provide First Aid management</p> <p>3.2 Reassure casualty in a caring and calm manner and make them comfortable</p> <p>3.3 Identify, obtain and apply use of First Aid resources and equipment appropriate to the identified risks and hazard controls</p> <p>3.4 Communicate with emergency control personnel the need for First Aid/medical assistance</p> <p>3.5 Monitor and respond to casualty's condition</p> <p>3.6 Finalise management of casualty</p>
4. Record and report incident	<p>4.1 Record details of casualty's physical condition, changes in conditions, management and response to management</p> <p>4.2 Convey details of casualty's condition and management activities to emergency services/relieving personnel</p> <p>4.3 Prepare and submit written incident reports</p> <p>4.4 Record and report use of first aid resources</p>
