Respond to emergency or incident situations</p>	<p>2.1 Identify, confirm and follow emergency evacuation procedures</p> <p>2.2 Coordinate and control response to emergency or incident</p> <p>2.3 Identify risks and/or hazards and communicate with signs, signals or barriers</p> <p>2.4 Select and use emergency equipment</p> <p>2.5 Take local measures to reduce impact of emergency or incident</p> <p>2.6 Continually monitor and assess emergency situation and changes in circumstances</p> <p>2.7 Communicate requests for further assistance or evacuation to</p>
