Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to apply and monitor underground coal mine emergency preparedness and response systems, including coordinating and controlling responses to incidents and participating in incident and procedure audits, debriefs and reviews.

It applies to those working in supervisory roles. They generally perform a broad range of operational activities in their area of responsibility and are responsible for monitoring a safe work environment.

Licensing, legislative and certification requirements that apply to this unit can vary between states, territories and industry sectors. Users must check requirements with relevant body before applying the unit.
