3. Handle and store bulk cargo	<p>3.1 Carry out bulk cargo transfer</p> <p>3.2 Monitor transfer of cargo</p> <p>3.3 Identify and report faults accurately and take appropriate remedial action within functional responsibility</p>
4. Assist with crane operations	<p>4.1 Use appropriate signals to direct movement of loads</p> <p>4.2 Identify and report faults and take appropriate remedial action within functional responsibility</p> <p>4.3 Relay information to crane operator</p>
