Application

Operate slewing crane within operating capacities of equipment to complete work activity	<p>2.1 Carry out equipment start-up checks in line with workplace procedures</p> <p>2.2 Identify faults and rectify within scope of own responsibility and according to workplace procedures</p> <p>2.3 Position, stabilise and level crane prior to commencement of lift operations</p> <p>2.4 Prepare loads for lift in accordance with crane limitations and rigging requirements, and according to workplace procedures</p> <p>2.5 Confirm the work area is clear and safe prior to commencing work activity</p> <p>2.6 Use crane controls and functions to lift and position using techniques suited to equipment capabilities, site and work conditions, and according to workplace procedures</p> <p>2.7 Monitor and manage equipment performance using indicators and alarms</p> <p>2.8 Monitor hazards and risks during operations, and ensure safety of self, other personnel, plant and equipment</p> <p>2.9 Park up, shut down, secure and carry out post operational inspection of equipment in line with workplace procedures</p>
3. Travel the crane	<p>3.1 Plan a firm and level route for the crane travel according to workplace procedures</p> <p>3.2 Monitor and manage hazards along the route</p> <p>3.3 Travel the crane in line with work requirements and workplace procedures</p>
4. Perform multiple crane lifts	<p>4.1 Obtain approval to carry out a multiple crane lift from the appropriate statutory authority prior to planning activity</p>
