Elements and Performance Criteria

1. Plan and prepare to conduct control centre operations	<p>1.1. Access, interpret and apply compliance documentation and procedures for control centre operations, and ensure the work activity is compliant</p> <p>1.2. Identify shift requirements from the previous shift report and confirm shift operational plan with the supervisor</p> <p>1.3. Communicate with all relevant personnel before commencement of operations</p> <p>1.4. Conduct pre-start checks</p>
2. Conduct control centre operations	<p>2.1. Start-up equipment and close down completely or partially in the sequence necessary to avoid damage/spillage</p> <p>2.2. Coordinate activities with others at the site prior to commencement of, and during the work activity</p>

	<p>2.3. Monitor and control plant processes to maintain shift plan and optimise coal stocks/quality and overburden removal</p> <p>2.4. Maintain control systems security requirements</p> <p>2.5. Monitor and act on warning devices</p> <p>2.6. Control the operation of equipment and the use of materials to minimise wastage</p> <p>2.7. Obtain and interpret emergency procedures, and be prepared for fire/accident/emergency.</p>
3. Record operational information	<p>3.1. Process written records and reporting requirements</p> <p>3.2. Carry out shift handover procedures</p>
4. Maintain standard practices	<p>4.1. Follow standards for safe and competent work practices</p> <p>4.2. Maintain control systems security requirements</p> <p>4.3. Control and monitor contractor access to mine and plant</p> <p>4.4. Observe safety rules and regulations</p>
