Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to conduct roadway maintenance in underground coal mining. This includes transporting resources, carrying out equipment and material checks and performing equipment inspections and operator maintenance.

It applies to those working in operational roles. They generally work under supervision to undertake a prescribed range of functions involving known routines and procedures and take some responsibility for the quality of work outcomes.

Licensing, legislative and certification requirements that apply to this unit can vary between states, territories and industry sectors. Users must check requirements with relevant body before applying the unit.

	2.3 Erect and post warning signals and signs according to site requirements

	2.7 Divert and drain roof and floor water according to job requirements
	2.8 Monitor hazards and confirm safe operation of plant and equipment
	2.9 Complete work plan according to job requirements
	2.10 Isolate services according to job requirements
3. Carry out operator maintenance on equipment	3.1 Prepare machine and equipment for maintenance according to manufacturer specifications and site requirements
	3.2 Carry out inspection and fault finding according to manufacturer specifications and site requirements
	3.3 Carry out scheduled maintenance tasks according to manufacturer specifications and site requirements
	3.4 Carry out housekeeping activities according to site requirements
	3.5 Complete maintenance records according to site requirements
