<p>2 Operate feeder breaker</p>	<p>2.1 Communicate and coordinate activities with others throughout the work activity</p> <p>2.2 Carry out pre-start, start-up, shutdown and isolation procedures</p> <p>2.3 Receive and confirm route and location plan, if necessary, by site inspection</p> <p>2.4 Complete roadway preparation and cable routes prior to relocation</p> <p>2.5 Carry out cable location and management</p> <p>2.6 Tow or move the feeder breaker into location and install</p> <p>2.7 Continually monitor hazards and risks, and ensure safety of self, other personnel, plant and equipment</p>
<p>3 Carry out operator maintenance</p>	<p>3.1 Prepare machine for maintenance</p> <p>3.2 Conduct inspection and fault finding</p> <p>3.3 Carry out scheduled maintenance tasks</p> <p>3.4 Conduct housekeeping activities</p> <p>3.5 Process written maintenance records</p>
