Break rock and remove	2.1 Select and access plant, tools and equipment for work activity 2.2 Identify and locate designated oversized rock/s 2.3 Assess rock and determine the correct method to break rock according to dimensions, location and grade of rock 2.4 Notify relevant personnel of rock breaking process 2.5 Apply correct techniques to achieve required rock size 2.6 Prepare and remove broken rocks
3. Conduct housekeeping activities	3.1 Clean, check, maintain and store plant, tools and equipment 3.2 Report issues identified with plant, tools and equipment
