Report on the execution of canal construction tasks</p>	<p>3.1 Complete and submit written reports as required</p> <p>3.2 Review the action plan, construction principles and resources used</p> <p>3.3 Identify training needs of team members and prepare training plans</p> <p>3.4 Submit reasoned recommendations to improve the safety, efficiency and effectiveness of the execution of canal construction tasks</p>
