Operate roller/compactor</p>	<p>2.1 Carry out start-up, park, shutdown and secure equipment procedures</p> <p>2.2 Coordinate activities with others at the site prior to commencement of, during and on completion of the work activity</p> <p>2.3 Drive and operate equipment within recommended speed, engine capability and limitations</p> <p>2.4 Engage and disengage the compacting device</p> <p>2.5 Assess materials and site conditions, and apply appropriate operating techniques</p> <p>2.6 Identify, remove or manage contaminants</p> <p>2.7 Compact to required degree of compaction</p> <p>2.8 Monitor and manage equipment performance using appropriate indicators, and ensure efficiency of operations</p>
