Operate wheeled dozer	<p>2.1 Coordinate activities with others at the site prior to commencement of, and during the work activity</p> <p>2.2 Carry out pre-start, start-up, park-up shutdown and secure equipment procedures</p> <p>2.3 Control speed and articulated steering of the wheeled dozer during tramming operations</p> <p>2.4 Use dozer controls and functions effectively, including manoeuvre attachments to complete tasks</p> <p>2.5 Carry out towing of equipment and plant safely within equipment and/or connection capabilities</p> <p>2.6 Maintain safe grip, traction and productivity in varied operating conditions</p> <p>2.7 Continually monitor hazards and risks, and ensure safety of self, other personnel, plant and equipment</p> <p>2.8 Complete work plan, within the operating capacities of equipment</p>
3. Carry out operator maintenance	<p>3.1 Prepare machine for maintenance</p> <p>3.2 Conduct inspection and fault finding</p> <p>3.3 Carry out scheduled maintenance tasks</p> <p>3.4 Return the machine to service</p> <p>3.5 Process written maintenance records</p>
4. Conduct housekeeping activities	<p>4.1 Clear work area and dispose of or recycle materials</p> <p>4.2 Process records</p>
