Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to apply trip pipe in drilling.

This unit applies to those working in operational roles. They generally perform tasks involving a broad range of skilled applications in a wide variety of contexts, which may involve some discretion and judgement in selecting equipment, services and contingency measures.

Plan and prepare for operations	1.1 Obtain, interpret and confirm work requirements 1.2 Access, interpret and apply trip pipe documentation and confirm work activity is compliant 1.3 Identify and minimise environmental issues and potential hazards, and assess and address risks within scope of own role and according to workplace procedures 1.4 Select and wear personal protective equipment required for work activity 1.5 Communicate with other personnel at site according to work requirements and confirm briefings and handover details are communicated and received

	1.6 Confirm availability and status of necessary permits to work according to operational and legislative requirements 1.7 Confirm availability of necessary third party utilities according to operational requirements
2. Prepare to trip tubulars	2.1 Check safety lines, ropes and air hoists/winch lines 2.2 Check equipment for safety and operations 2.3 Line up trip tank if applicable to equipment in use 2.4 Prepare pipe racking system
3. Trip and rack tubulars	3.1 Assist in tripping in and out using required techniques based on the lifting equipment and tripping method used 3.2 Rack and store tubular based on the lifting equipment and tripping method used 3.3 Record tasks where required
