3 Load out and move	<p>3.1 Confirm transport arrangements and directions to new lease</p> <p>3.2 Apply correct rigging practices for rig removal and loading</p> <p>3.3 Brief crews, assign specific tasks and monitor operations</p> <p>3.4 Monitor rig/camp move and complete and forward reports</p>
4 Oversee housekeeping activities	<p>4.1 Clean, check, maintain and store plant, tools and equipment</p>
