Operate stacker	<p>2.1 Coordinate activities with others prior to commencement of, and during, the work activity</p> <p>2.2 Carry out pre-start, start-up, park-up, shutdown and secure equipment procedures</p> <p>2.3 Operate controls and stack materials</p> <p>2.4 Act on or report monitoring systems and alarms</p> <p>2.5 Complete the work plan within the operating capacities of the equipment</p> <p>2.6 Carry out reporting and complete and process documents</p>
3. Carry out operator maintenance	<p>3.1 Prepare machine for maintenance</p> <p>3.2 Conduct inspections and fault finding procedures</p> <p>3.3 Carry out scheduled maintenance tasks</p> <p>3.4 Provide operator support during preparation for, and conduct of, major maintenance tasks</p> <p>3.5 Process written maintenance records</p>
4. Carry out housekeeping activities	<p>4.1 Clear work area and dispose of or recycle materials</p> <p>4.2 Clean and maintain condition of equipment, ensure suitability for use, and address/report issues</p> <p>4.3 Manage and/or report hazards, and maintain a safe working environment</p> <p>4.4 Process written records</p>
