2. Pelletise materials	2.1 Monitor and maintain required pressure throughout the bed 2.2 Confirm feeder is clear of debris and build-up 2.3 Check and confirm condition of pallet seal and wind box to prevent leakage 2.4 Deposit pellets across full width of the grate 2.5 Operate at full bed depth and grate speed
3. Condition pellets for load out	3.1 Ensure maintenance of maximum depth of pellets on pallets 3.2 Regulate temperature to plant requirements 3.3 Minimise leakage of air 3.4 Crush and screen oversize material 3.5 Extract specific quantities of material at size required for work activity 3.6 Ensure walkways are clear of spillage and scrap 3.7 Pass on shift changeover details to oncoming shift
