3 Implement the quality plan	<p>3.1 Document how the quality management plan will be introduced or enhanced</p> <p>3.2 Provide information and resources for the implementation of the quality management plan, in a form readily accessible to others, in a timely and consistent manner</p> <p>3.3 Provide required training and support to others on the implementation of the quality management plan</p> <p>3.4 Maintain quality management plan records</p>
4 Monitor and update the quality management processes	<p>4.1 Monitor the reviews statistics and outcomes of the systems procedures, in consultation with others, if procedures and practices need to be modified to meet quality management plan targets</p> <p>4.2 Amend the quality management plan and its implementation when changes are anticipated</p> <p>4.3 Retain documentation stating reasons for changes</p>
