Carry out service and repairs of screens</p>	<p>2.1 Carry out inspection of screens, fault find and report outcomes</p> <p>2.2 Select, check for faults and use appropriate servicing and maintenance tools</p> <p>2.3 Select and operate servicing and maintenance items</p> <p>2.4 Carry out servicing of screens</p> <p>2.5 Carry out maintenance of screens</p> <p>2.6 Dispose of waste, including used oil, lubricants and other materials</p> <p>2.7 Check for faults, return and secure all tools and re-usable items</p> <p>2.8 Maintain servicing and maintenance records</p>
