Conduct work activities from elevated platform	<p>3.1 Use approved safety devices and ensure safety of personnel and surrounding site</p> <p>3.2 Monitor and manage equipment performance using appropriate indicators</p> <p>3.3 Operate equipment safely within work environment, road conditions and limitations</p> <p>3.4 Complete all required documentation clearly, concisely and on time</p> <p>3.5 Pass on end of shift information verbally or in writing to oncoming shift</p>
4. Carry out operator maintenance	<p>4.1 Carry out shutdown procedures</p> <p>4.2 Carry out operator maintenance, service and make minor adjustments to equipment</p>
