## Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to operate from elevated work platforms underground in coal and metalliferous mining, including positioning, setting up and stabilising work platforms and carrying out operator maintenance.

It applies to those working in operational roles. They generally work under supervision to undertake a prescribed range of functions involving known routines and procedures and take some responsibility for the quality of work outcomes.

Licensing, legislative and certification requirements that apply to this unit can vary between states, territories and industry sectors. Users must check requirements with relevant body before applying the unit.

Carry out operator maintenance and housekeeping	4.1 Carry out shutdown procedures according to manufacturer specifications and site requirements 4.2 Carry out operator maintenance, service and make minor adjustments to equipment according to manufacturer specifications and site requirements 4.3 Clean and maintain equipment according to manufacturer specifications and site requirements 4.4 Clean and store auxiliary service equipment according to site requirements
