Plan and prepare for conducting cage operations</p>	<p>1.1 Access, interpret and apply documentation and procedures for conducting cage operations and ensure the work activity is compliant</p> <p>1.2 Receive, interpret and clarify shift changeover details</p> <p>1.3 Select and wear appropriate personal protective equipment</p> <p>1.4 Perform equipment and work area pre-start checks</p> <p>1.5 Check records for outstanding maintenance/inspections and recorded defects and take action</p> <p>1.6 Identify, address and report potential risks and hazards</p> <p>1.7 Carry out start-up procedures, including checking that area is clear for operations</p> <p>1.8 Identify, address and report environmental issues</p> <p>1.9 Adhere to emergency procedures</p>
<p>2. Operate cage</p>	<p>2.1 Load cage within capacity and comply with specified limits</p> <p>2.2 Position and secure loads in or attached to cage prior to transit</p> <p>2.3 Communicate with relevant personnel</p> <p>2.4 Operate cage safely</p> <p>2.5 Monitor and manage cage performance using appropriate indicators</p> <p>2.6 Complete all required written documentation clearly, concisely and on time</p> <p>2.7 Pass on end of shift information verbally or in writing to oncoming shift</p>
<p>3. Transport explosives in the cage</p>	<p>3.1 Identify explosives used on site</p> <p>3.2 Determine and ensure the segregation and separation of detonators and explosives</p> <p>3.3 Secure and transport blasting agents and explosives</p> <p>3.4 Track and record in writing movement of explosives and detonators</p>
<p>4. Carry out operator maintenance</p>	<p>4.1 Isolate cage before conducting operator maintenance</p> <p>4.2 Service and make minor adjustments to equipment</p> <p>4.3 Restore cage operations</p>
