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Modification History

This unit replaces RIIWHS403D Apply the work health and safety management system. Significant endorseable amendments have been made to Elements, Performance Criteria, Foundation Skills, Performance Evidence and Knowledge Evidence to better reflect current industry practices and clarify training outcomes.

Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to apply the work health and safety management system in the mining, drilling and civil infrastructure industry.

This unit applies to individuals working in a range of supervisory roles. Work is performed under minimal supervision and competency requires a high level of judgement and decision-making.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.

Foundation Skills

Skill	Description
Reading	Identifies and interprets information from workplace procedures, policies, documentation and systems
Writing	Produces and completes workplace reports, including workplace resourcing and work health and safety records, using appropriate vocabulary, grammatical structures and conventions
Oral communication	 Presents information or assistance using industry specific vocabulary Uses listening and questioning to clarify and confirm understanding
