<p>2 Comply with Government Regulations and Company Policies</p>	<p>2.1 Communicate clearly and concisely regulations and procedures for controlling work and hazards to team members both on the rig floor and in camp accommodation areas</p> <p>2.2 Allocate employees' job responsibilities in accordance with regulations/company policies and within the bounds of their competence</p> <p>2.3 Maintains and demonstrates the standard for complying with regulation and policies</p> <p>2.4 Ensure team work rules are agreed, applied and modelled by all crew members</p> <p>2.5 Ensure regulations are obeyed by crew in line with statutory compliance</p> <p>2.6 Constantly assess rig operators against regulations and policies</p>
