This unit of competency describes the skills and knowledge required to carry out construction or installation tasks to stock culture or holding structures or systems and farm structures.

The unit applies to individuals who carry out construction or installation tasks in an aquaculture workplace that do not require the employment of qualified tradespersons or the attainment of appropriate licences to meet state/territory and local government requirements.

All work must be carried out to comply with workplace procedures, according to state/territory health and safety, food safety, biosecurity and environmental regulations, legislation and standards that apply to the workplace.
