Performance Evidence

An individual demonstrating competency must satisfy all of the elements and performance criteria of this unit.

There must be evidence that the individual has performed mobile surveillance for at least one surveillance operation, including:

- selecting and preparing surveillance team and required equipment for the operation
- identifying, monitoring and documenting surveillance of subject
- · maintaining security of equipment and evidence
- applying appropriate foot and/or driving surveillance skills for the covert nature of the surveillance
- applying the appropriate actions in responding to contingencies
- communicating and working effectively as part of the surveillance team.

Knowledge Evidence

An individual must be able to demonstrate the knowledge required to perform the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit. This includes knowledge of:

- jurisdictional policies, procedures and laws relating to mobile surveillance operations and evidentiary requirements
- local knowledge relevant to surveillance operations
- · surveillance and anti/counter-surveillance methods used in mobile surveillance operations
- use of surveillance and communications equipment for mobile surveillance operations.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment of skills must take place under the following conditions:

- physical conditions:
 - skills must be demonstrated in a surveillance operation setting or an environment that accurately represents workplace conditions

- resources, equipment and materials:
 - surveillance equipment relevant to vehicle and foot surveillance
- specifications:
 - access to jurisdictional policies, procedures and legislation relating to mobile surveillance operations and evidence
 - surveillance plan
 - running sheets
- relationships:
 - evidence of interactions with work team.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
