Performance Evidence

An individual demonstrating competency must satisfy all of the elements and performance criteria in this unit.

There must be evidence that the individual has:

• harvested crocodile eggs with at least one extra person on at least three occasions.

In doing the above, there must also be evidence that the individual has:

- complied with crocodile risk and safety standards
- treated crocodiles humanely
- handled crocodile eggs with care
- followed legislation, regulations and codes of practice associated with crocodiles
- · complied with biosecurity guidelines
- communicated with relevant parties.

Knowledge Evidence

An individual must be able to demonstrate the knowledge required to perform the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit. This includes knowledge of:

- crocodile egg harvesting techniques
- crocodile egg condition
- safe and humane crocodile handling techniques and procedures
- the principles of crocodile welfare and ethics as set out in relevant codes of practice
- safe crocodile egg handling, including:
 - · avoiding damage to eggs through rough handling or jolting
 - stacking eggs carefully in crates or containers
- workplace health and safety standards related to crocodile operations, including use of personal protective equipment (PPE)
- culturally sensitive communication protocol
- relevant crocodile activity regulations, including biosecurity control measures.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment of the skills in this unit of competency must take place under the following conditions:

- physical conditions:
 - skills must be demonstrated in an environment that accurately represents workplace conditions
- resources, equipment and materials:
 - access to crocodile nests
 - equipment required for crocodile egg harvesting
- specifications:
 - · crocodile safety documentation, policies and procedures
- relationships:
 - team member(s).

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
