Performance Evidence

An individual demonstrating competency must satisfy all of the elements and performance criteria in this unit.

There must be evidence that the individual has managed the crew and vessel for at least one fishing operation, including:

- coordinating and communicating the safety requirements and responsibilities of each crew member
- using personal protective equipment
- monitoring and rectifying unsafe or hazardous practices
- safely controlling vessel speed and position under varying conditions
- instructing and overseeing crew in the compliance of relevant regulatory requirements
- maintaining catch reporting and vessel monitoring systems to fisheries regulatory requirements.

Knowledge Evidence

An individual must be able to demonstrate the knowledge required to perform the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit. This includes knowledge of:

- communication systems, including hand signals used in fishing operations
- crew numbers required for safe fishing operations
- dimensions and likely movement of other encountered fishing operations
- effects of loading on vessel stability
- effects of vessel orientation on vessel movement and stability
- safe work practices relevant to fishing operations
- techniques and procedures for dealing with abnormal operating conditions
- vessel speed requirements for fishing operations and safety
- fisheries and other regulations relevant to fishing operations
- operating principles of gear common to the operational area.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment of skills must take place under the following conditions:

- physical conditions:
 - skills must be demonstrated in a fishing operations environment or an environment that accurately represents workplace conditions
- resources, equipment and materials:
 - fully operational fishing vessel
 - reporting and monitoring systems
- specifications:
 - workplace procedures for fishing operations
 - access to fisheries and other relevant regulations
- relationships:
 - evidence of interactions with crew members.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
