 - · workplace conflict.

- a simulated industry environment.

Assessment must ensure access to:

- relevant documentation:
 - organisational policies and procedures for:
 - standards of performance
 - addressing poor performance
 - · dealing with workplace conflict
 - · organisational standards of performance
- team members; these can be:
 - · individuals in an industry workplace, or
 - individuals who participate in role plays or simulated activities, set up for the purpose
 of assessment, in a simulated industry environment.

Assessors must satisfy the Standards for Registered Training Organisations' requirements for assessors.
